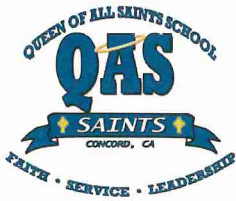

Class Description**

**Creative Arts – Open to all ages (9:00-10:15)**

Students will use their creative talents to make masterpieces! They will use different mediums and a variety of materials to create treasures and artwork to display at home.

**Robotics and Coding - Open to Students Entering Grades 3-8 Only (9:00-10:15)**

Students will complete projects that will introduce coding and computer science. Projects are theme based to attract varied interest.

Goals:

- increase confidence when using computers
- increase confidence in trying new things
- help with problem solving of difficult tasks
- demonstrate the impact computer science has in careers and communities

**Foodie Fun – Open to all ages (10:30-Noon)**

Students will create yummy child-friendly food. They will learn about nutrition and the importance of eating healthy food, and will also share some favorite foods and family recipes.
