

ANNUAL AUCTION FAQs:

- Q: *How many hours am I required to volunteer towards Auction?*
- A: Families receiving tuition assistance/scholarship should see their contract for additional information regarding Auction volunteer requirements.
- Q: *How do I sign up to help with auction?*
- A: If you are looking to help with your time for auction before, during or after you must attend the "All-Volunteer Auction Meetings" to sign up for specific jobs. To avoid confusion, we do not list these jobs on the Sign-Up Genius. Please do not show up the day of the auction to help if you have not signed up prior.
- Q: *What if my donated item wasn't purchased by me and I don't have a receipt? (i.e. un-used gift card)*
- A: If you have an unused gift card or new with tags item, we must be able to verify value. You will receive credit based on that value.
- Q: *Where do I log my volunteer hours?*
- A: In the office Volunteer Binder, you will find the blue color-coded auction volunteer log. Please use this specific log towards auction hours only. Continue to use the white color volunteer logs for all other volunteer hours.
- Q: *Will there be child care on the night of the auction?*
- A: Yes. You must pre-register your child(s) prior to the night of auction on the auction web site. (www.accelevents.com/events/QASauction2018) No refunds for change of registration.
- Q: *Do my donations count towards my fundraising obligation?*
- A: Auction donations do not count towards your family fundraising. They do however, receive credit for volunteer hours. Every \$20 is a credit of one service hour. You MUST include a receipt for the donated item.
- Q: *Is there an opportunity to receive hours over the Summer?*
- A: Yes! We have committees that are looking for additional help over the Summer; or see Sign-Up Genius for more items requested. (www.signupgenius.com/go/4090f49aea922a0fa7-queen)
