Notification of Health Requirement for School Entry

Dear Parents,

The first year at school is a very important time in your child's life. Experience has shown that children who are not well cannot profit fully from the school program. In order to provide your child with the maximum opportunity to learn, he/she should be in the best possible health.

For Kindergarten entry: documentation of all immunizations and a negative PPD/Mantoux Tuberculin Skin Test or "Negative Risk" Assessment on or after the 4th birthday is required. **Physical examination by a physician is required prior to entry to First Grade.**

For First Graders: physical examination by a physician is required within the last 18 months before entry.

For new students in grades 2-8: a physical examination by a physician is required within the last two years before entry. The "Report of Health Examination" (PM 171) is the form to be used or any form signed by an MD, and stamped or with an office letterhead.

New student transfers from out of state or country: must also have a current (within two year) negative TB Risk Assessment signed by an MD. If the PPD skin test is used it must be read and documented by a health care provider to be valid.

If your child is transferring from another public or private school, records must be received by QAS on or before the first day of school.

If your child has a chronic health condition such as asthma or diabetes, please bring all instructions and information, signed by your health care provider, by the first day of school.

Thank you for your cooperation and we are looking forward to welcoming your child on the first day of school.
